Open Match Game Tournament Rules:

1. Current members of the Greater Charleston USBC Association of the 2011-2012 bowling season will be eligible to participate provided they have bowled a minimum of 21 games in an USBC sanctioned league during the 2010-2011 season in the Greater Charleston USBC Association area. This includes Summer 2011 leagues.
2. All bowling will be on a scratch basis.
3. Each participant will bowl two (2) four game qualifying blocks on Saturday and earn points, plus or minus, based on a scratch score of 200 for each qualifying game. The top eight (8) qualifiers will advance to match play on Sunday with qualifying scores carrying forward to the match play finals. Adjustments to the number of qualifiers may be made should tournament participation be small. In case of a tie for eighth place, a one game roll-off immediately following the qualifying competition will be held. There will be no alternate. Should a finalist fail to participate on Sunday, their opponent will automatically earn the win and bonus points, but still must bowl for score.
4. Match play finals on Sunday will be scratch with thirty (30) bonus points awarded to the winner of each game. Each finalist will bowl the other seven (7) finalists once, with the eighth and final game being a position round. In case of a tie for first place at the end of the eighth game, a one game roll-off will be held to determine the winner. The winner will be declared the Greater Charleston USBC Association City Open Match Game Champion and will be presented with first place money and a championship plaque.
5. The Tournament Director has the authority to disqualify any contestant for unsportsmanlike conduct or improper attire during the tournament and to make decisions regarding tournament play. Proper attire is required and is adapted from the **USBC Open National Tournament**. (1) Men and women participants must wear a shirt with a butterfly-type collar and casual slacks, trousers or jeans. (Women may wear Capri pants provided the length is below the knees). (2) Mock collared or collarless dress shirts will be permitted provided they are worn with casual slacks or trousers. Bowlers may NOT wear jeans with either of these two shirt styles. Ordinary T-shirts will not be permitted. (3) During the tournament, bowlers are NOT permitted to wear hats, sweats, shorts, skirts, skorts, culottes or zupas (pants with elastic cuffs) (4) All clothing must be neat, clean and in good condition. (5) Hats or head coverings will only be allowed for medical reasons.
6. All fees paid towards prize money will be returned 100%. Any lineage money collected that is over and above that needed to pay for the games bowled will be added to the Prize Fund
7. A **\$30.00** fee will be charged for all returned checks. Future payments must then be made by cash, money order or bank check, as no more personal checks will be accepted.
