### Article VI Officers

#### Section C. Term

The term for elected officers is two years, not to exceed three years in a term. The Board, adult members and Youth Representatives determine the number of years in a term and the number of terms allowed, and a stagger system.

The stagger system is as follows:

**First year elections:** President and 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President

**Second year elections:** 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President and Sgt.-At-Arms

*NOTE: Due to the current 1 year term election of officers, the initial first year elections will be for 2 year terms for the President and 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President while the 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President and Sgt.-At-Arms will be elected for a 1 year term. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President and Sgt.-At-Arms will then be elected again in the second year elections for a 2 year term hence installing the stagger system.*
